Terms and Conditions

Purchase confirmation	Purchase of a Market Day stall-site will be confirmed when payment has been received and a registration form completed. Sales are made on a first-in first-served basis until all available spaces are filled.
	Acceptance of stalls is at the discretion of the PTA.
Refunds	Stall-site sales are non-refundable. The Market Day event will proceed unless there are extreme weather conditions.
Location of stall-sites	Stall-holders will be directed to a specific stall-site on the day when they arrive to set up their stall.
	The exact location of your stall-site on the school grounds will not be pre-allocated.
	No vehicles will be permitted on the main field.
What can be sold	Stall-holders are able to sell whatever goods they choose except for: running a sausage sizzle (St Albans School PTA will run one on the day) Candy Floss (St Albans PTA selling this) Cans of drink and coffees/hot chocolates (St Albans PTA selling these, Oak Leaf café will be open) alcohol anything that might be considered unsuitable for sale at a school community event.
Car Boot Sites	 Car Boot sites: cost \$25 each measure 6m x 3m, they are designed to fit a car and a trestle sized table may be run by an individual or a group of people (families, friends, sports team, community group etc) are the same price regardless of whether the stall-holder is a commercial enterprise, not for profit organisation or private individual/s. All equipment is to be provided by the stall holder.

Kids Market	Kid's Market stalls:
Stalls	are to be run by childrencost \$5 each
	 are the size of half a trestle table (provided by the organisers)
	■ may be run by an individual child or a group of children
	Note: Parents / Caregivers are responsible for supervision of their child/ren
Unsold goods and rubbish	All unsold goods and rubbish are the responsibility of the individual stall-holders and need be taken off-site at the end of the event.
Vehicle entry to	Vehicle entry onto the school grounds:
Car Boot sites	 is via Sheppard place on presentation of the stall-holder's ticket
	(supplied one week prior to the Market Day)
	 will be restricted to one vehicle/drop-off per stall-site will be available from 9.30am until 10.45am only
	wiii be available from elecam antii 10. Ioam only
	Note: For safety reasons, no vehicles will be allowed to drive onto or off the school grounds between 10.45am and 1.15pm.
Vehicle entry for Kids Market Stalls	To reduce the amount of traffic on the school grounds on Market Day, no vehicle access for drop-off or pick-up of goods for Kids Market stalls will be allowed.
	Prior to setting up your stall you will be required to present your Stallholder Ticket, at which time you will be allocated a table.
Money	All money taken, floats, change etc is the stall-holder's individual responsibility. The organisers will not provide any money handling services (including EFT POS) during the event. The organisers will not take any commission on stall-holders' takings.
	Stallholders must not pass on any costs they incur to the PTA.
Supply of equipment	The organisers will not provide any equipment such as tables, tents etc. All equipment is the responsibility of the individual stall-holders.
Sales prior to start time.	It is up to stallholders whether they begin sales early.
Safety	 Please be conscious of the Safety of yourself and others at all times. Free sunblock will be available on the day There is a speed limit of 5km/hr on school grounds Hazard lights must be used while driving No driving will be permitted on the grounds between 10:45am and 1:15pm
Advertising	The organisers will widely promote the event. Stall-holders are welcome to do additional advertising
